

## PM unfurls poverty alleviation plan; will it really work?



The Prime Minister of Pakistan, Imran Khan, on March 28, 2019 announced poverty alleviation plan through a power point presentation prepared by same old bureaucracy, which has been instrumental with same spirit during the past governments also. Ever since inception of Pakistan, respective democratically elected and dictatorial governments used to introduce such plans; created separate dedicated institutions and spent billions on media campaigns just to highlight the initiative but what did we actually achieve at the end of the day? Nothing, Poor continue to be the poor

in Pakistan. Homeless continue to be the homeless in this land of the pure and corrupt people continue to be the corrupt. Nothing has changed in last 70 years and presumably nothing is likely to change, if remedial measures are not taken.

The first six months of PTI government have literally taken heavy toll on especially the downtrodden class. People find it difficult to make their both ends meet. But we are told that if winter comes, can spring be far behind. So, put up for a while and wait for good days. The only plus point is that PM Imran Khan himself has a genuine desire to streamline things. This good intention however needs to be followed by practical steps.

The reason, that why such plans always fail is quite obvious. Nations and societies are not built and poverty is not alleviated by metro buses or housing schemes. It is rule of law; social justice; principles of equality and following of teachings of religion, which transform a mob into a vibrant nation. None of them is unfortunately in vogue in Pakistan.

The PM often quotes examples of China that how has it overcome monster of poverty by massive executions of the corrupt ministers and people. But how many corrupt people have been hanged in Pakistan so far? And how many ministers have been shown the door on corruption charges?

The beauty of our legal system is that it helps the haves and further persecutes the have-nots. Our law moulds itself in favour of the powerful people while it has no relief for the hapless and the poor. No plan can work here until and unless these fundamental issues are addressed and the Constitution is followed in letter and spirit.

#### Roads of diplomatic enclave in a shambles

Majority of roads in the high-security zone i.e Diplomatic Enclave are in a shambles. Despite repeated pleas by the affected diplomatic missions, the authorities responsible for the maintenance remain unmoved. According to a survey, the main road where important embassies including France, Thailand, Italy, the Netherlands, USA, Russian, and China are located, is extremely in a bad shape.

Most parts of the said road are destroyed either due to lack of maintenance of excessive rains. In addition, number of foreign missions on this road has increased with the passage of time however the length and breadth of the road remains the same as it was 20 years ago.

The roads in the posh sectors such as F 6 and F 7 are also in bad condition and foreign missions located in these sectors are facing same challenges.

A senior diplomat on the condition of not being named, said they have written dozens of letters to the CDA but all in vain. He further said that it should be a matter of prestige and dignity for the host country as the apathy of the authorities was earning bad name for the department and the country. "If you do not pay heed to the problems of the respective country, it means you do not respect that country", he added.

# Potential of Uzbekistan in Ziyarah tourism

Minister of Uzbekistan Aziz


Minister of Uzbekistan Aziz A. Abdukhakimov spoke during the inaugural session and said the event shall give a considerable boost to the tourism industry of Uzbekistan, especially the Ziyarah tourism. Delegates from over 34 countries including Pakistan attended the Forum. Despite being the first-ever forum of its kind, the platform provided the participants with an opportunity of having detailed information about the Ziyarah tourism potential of Uzbekistan. The Forum was organized as per the vision of the President of Uzbekistan Shavkat Mirziyoyev who wants development of tourism at a fast speed. Since the Presidential decree, developing tourism has become a major priority for Uzbekistan, a landlocked country in Central Asia with great landscapes and a

very rich historical heritage. Uzbekistan has recently put a strong emphasis on developing its air fleet, in part by acquiring Boeing's Dreamliner long-haul aircraft, and high-speed train connections, including to Samarkand, an ancient city that is on UNESCO's World Heritage List.

The Deputy Prime Minister of Uzbekistan who is also the head of complex of sports and tourism welcomed the guests and hoped the trip would contribute to enrichment of their knowledge about Ziyarah tourism. He said flow of tourists to Uzbekistan has multiplied manifold adding one of the key reasons in this effect was liberalization of visa policy. He said the new visa region introduced by the Uzbek government allows tourists from across the globe to have an easy entry in Uzbekistan. He said his country was consistently implementing comprehensive measures to develop the tourism industry as one of the strategic sectors of the national economy, which ensures the accelerated development of the regions, increasing the income and quality of life of the population, as well as improving

the investment attractiveness. He said the objective of this Forum is to promote opportunities and potential of the country, as well s the international recognition of Uzbekistan as one of the largest centers of Zivarah tourism in the Islamic World. The Forum was organized by the State



The Forum participants were informed about the country's tourism potential, recent reforms in the field of doing business in the tourism industry, and opportunities created for foreign investors.



#### TOURISM POLICE

Tourism police is ostensibly a unique idea and Uzbekistan ranks perhaps at the top among those countries, which have introduced a dedicated tourism police for the facilitation and protection of tourists visiting Uzbekistan. Despite being a frequently traveler across the globe, I did not come across any police that was fully devoted to protection of tourists.

They lady told me that they belong to normal police however keeping in view their ability to communicate in multiple languages they are assigned this job. Pakistan is also in the process of re-invigorating its tourism industry therefore it can learn from the experiences of Uzbekistan. Introduction of a similar tourism police force exclusively for the touristic places will help improve flow of foreign tourists. With a better security situation, tourism industry undoubtedly will get a considerable boost.



Undoubtedly, this steps has not only encouraged more and more tourists to come to Uzbekistan but also sent positive vides throughout the world that if they visit Uzbekistan for tourism purposes, they shall be properly taken care of.

I had a chance to interview members of tourism police at Shah-e-Zinda and then at the mazar of Imam Bokhari. Always patrolling in a duo, i.e. a male and a female, the tourism police representatives told me that our first and foremost job is to provide security to the tourists. They are our esteemed guests therefore it is our utmost responsibility to protect then and guide them to their




#### BULLET TRAIN

The Tashkent to Samarkand high-speed rail line is a 344-kilometre (214 mi) high-speed rail connection between Tashkent and Samarkand, the two largest Uzbek cities. The route passes through four provinces: Tashkent, Sirdaryo, Jizzakh and Samarqand in Uzbekistan. Trains operate seven days a week under the brand Afrosiyob. A 141 km long extension to Qarshi started operation on August 22, 2015, though at lower speed of 160 kph. An extension to Bukhara on the Talgo 250 ran for the first time on August 25, 2016 — marking the completion of a project to modernise the 256 km route from Samarkand. Travel from Tashkent to

#### BUKHARA POTENTIAL


Bukhara is one of the oldest cities of Uzbekistan with a thousand years of history. Bukhara is a holy city of Muslim world. There are many mosques, shrines, madrasahs, with the latest one among them dating back to the XIX century, preserved there.

The historic center of Bukhara has been listed by UNESCO as one of the World Heritage Sites. You will need at least two days to do Bukhara main architectural sights. Bukhara is a city-museum, with about 140 architectural monuments. The nation's fifthlargest city, it had a population of 247,644 as of 31 August 2016. People have inhabited the region around Bukhara for at least five millennia, and the city has existed for half that time. The mother tongue of the majority of people of Bukhara is Tajik.Located on the Silk Road, the city has long served as a center of trade, scholarship, culture, and religion. UNESCO has listed the historic center of Bukhara (which contains numerous mosques and madrasas) as a World Heritage Site.

of Central Asian history and art. The region of Bukhara was a part of the Persian Empire for a long time. The origin of many of its current inhabitants goes back to the period of Aryan immigration into the region.

Char Minor (alternatively spelled Chor Minor, and also alternatively known as the Madrasah of Khalif Niyaz-kul) is a building tucked away in a lane northeast of the Lyabi Hauz complex. The structure was built by Khalif Niyaz-kul, a wealthy Bukharan of Turkmen origin in the 19th century under the rule of the Janid dynasty.[22] The four-towered structure is sometimes mistaken for a gate to the madras that once existed behind the structure; however, the Char-Minar is actually a complex of buildings with two functions, ritual and shelter.

This research centre is headquartered at the Imam Al-Bukhari Academy in Samarkand and affiliated to the OIC. It spans over acres of land. Also situated in the juxtaposition of Imam Al Bukhari tomb, the research center too is frequented by hundreds of people, who visit the place and are briefed about the importance of the Center and various research facilities provided in the Center.

Since Uzbekistan has started to reach out to the outer world, especially in the field of Ziyarah tourism, one is pleasantly surprised to know that the country has contributed a lot to enrich human history, through its scholars such as Imam Al-Bukhari, Imam At-Termizi, Mahmud Az-Zamakhshari, Muhammad Al-Khawarazmi, Burhaniddin Marginani, Abu Raihan Beruni, Abu Ali ibn Sina and others. As rightly remarked by the Uzbek President, Imam Bukhari is acclaimed all over the world as the compilator of "Sahih Al Bukhari" the second most important source in Islam after Quran". The idea of the research center first came under discussion in 2016 when as an interim President of Uzbekistan Shavkat Mirziyoyev took up this plan with the OIC leadership, who

And above all, the building of the Center in itself was





the two-day forum.


Here is the text of the declaration. "Bukhara Declaration on Ziyarah Tourism Adopted at the First International Forum on Zivarah Tourism February 22, 2019, Friday (17 Jumada Al-Akhirah, 1440) in the city of Bukhara, Republic of Uzbekistan. 


One of the sectors of tourism – Ziyarah Tourism has grown exponentially and became one of the leading trends for the 21st century, contributing



Sardar Yar Mohammad Rind, a renowned politicians, Adviser to the Prime Minister and PTI leader gave exclusive interview to CENTRELINE and DNA. He talked about various issues including Pakistan, India relations, CPEC, opening of Gwadar port and government performance. Here are excerpts from his interview.



1: How would you see Pakistan, India relations and Pakistan government and military response to Indian aggression?

Let me first congratulated Pakistan's valiant leadership and military top brass for foiling nefarious designs of India. The way Pakistan handled the issue, especially at the world stage, needs fulsome applause. Pakistan ostensibly pleaded its case at all forums quite well and in an impressive manner. The way our foreign office reached out to capitals of the world speaks volumes for Pakistan's strong desire for regional peace and stability. The PTI government spearheaded by Prime Minister Imran Khan strongly believes in peaceful co-existence particularly with neighbors. Pakistan's peace overtures must not be construed as weakness for Pakistan wants to settle disputes with India in peaceful manner. Prime Minister Imran Khan undoubtedly won hearts of not only people of Pakistan but people of India also by letting the Indian pilot go.

In the present times no country can afford to indulge in wars therefore it is expected that better sense will prevail in India and there leaders would exercise responsibility in the coming days in order to avoid any catastrophic situation. Kashmir remains the core issue between the two countries therefore an early solution will contribute towards regional peace and stability. Kashmir issue should be resolved in accordance with the UN

resolutions.

2: How do you view the CPEC project and its far-reaching effects in the regional and elsewhere?

CPEC ostensibly is a game changer especially for the people of Baluchistan. The project inter alia has created many job opportunities for the local people. Once completed, the project is likely to help Pakistan overcome its economic challenges. Let me add here that further extension of CPEC to neighboring countries such Uzbekistan, Tajikistan, Kazakhstan etc would surely help link Pakistan with this region as well. Central Asia is rich in energy resources and Pakistan being an energydeficient country can benefit from Central Asian states expertise in this particular field. In addition, Saudi Arabia's joining of CPEC would also help boost credentials of this project. Saudi decision to set up a state of the art oil refinery with an estimated cost of USD 10 billion would surely help Pakistan overcome its energy related problems. Gwadar undoubtedly happens to be Pakistan's jewel in the crown. Due to its huge strategic importance, it has become center of attraction for all countries. Through Gwadar port Pakistan will inshallah achieve goal of economic self-reliance.

#### 3: How do to see so far performance of the government?

The government under the leadership of Imran Khan is doing quite well. No doubt, we have some challenges also but as you know that the government comprises mostly those politicians, who have taken charge of their respective offices for the first time, therefore they took some time to settle down. However, they all are well entrenched now and serving the people with their utmost capabilities. I would particularly like to mention names of senior PTI leader Naeem ul Haq the Prime Minister adviser on political affairs and Iftikhar Durrani the head of media team. Both these persons have put in their best efforts to

military suffered losses in war on terror just to make sure that people of Pakistan get a peaceful and secure environment to live.

Therefore sacrifices rendered by armed forces of Pakistan need to be recognized. The ambassador said there are six political parties in Kazakhstan and have full independence to take part in

elections. Nursultan Nazarbayev party is currently ruling the country.

He said it is not clear right now that how many candidates shall be vying for the coveted slot however in Kazakhstan everybody is independent to take part in elections.

To a question the ambassador said Nursultan Nazarbayev shall continue to be the chairman of the Security Council; member of the constitutional court and head of the Nur Otan party.

'An authoritative opinion of the leader



of the nationl will have a particular, even, priority importance in the development and adoption of strategic decisions', he added.

Kazakhstan he said has become an authoritative and influential participant in global peace processes, the country was elected to the UN Security Council for 2017-2018, received world recognition as the leader of the global movement for nuclear nonproliferation and disarmament, as well as an impartial mediator in interfaith

While giving a synopsis of Kazakh society, the ambassador said the country has become a territory of harmony, accord, and tolerance between all peoples and religious denominations. Thanks to the historical synthesis of world religions, languages, cultures and traditions, Kazakhstan has formed a society in which peace and harmony have become an integral part of our political culture.

While talking about Kazakhstan-Pakistan relations the ambassador said, leadership of Pakistan has always paid great attention to Kazakhstan and its

foreign policy initiatives.

All presidents and prime ministers of Pakistan starting from Prime Minister Benazir Bhutto visited Kazakhstan either as bilateral visit or within the framework of multilateral forums. 



### **Taxila**




The ancient settlement of Taxila in the western outskirts of the twin cities of Rawalpindi and Islamabad is a UNESCO World Heritage Site; it is considered one of the most important archaeological sites of South Asia, and for good reason. There is a modern town with the archaeological sites scattered nearby.

### Jaulian Buddha statue

Taxila was originally Takshashila meaning the hill capital of the Takshakas, a bronze age (3rd and 2nd millennium BCE) tribe. In its glory days it was one of the main cities of the ancient Kingdom of Gandhara, which existed from roughly 1000 BCE to 1000 CE and included much of what are now northern Pakistan and eastern Afghanistan. What makes Taxila unique and fascinating is the mainly Buddhist art and architecture of the Gandharan period, though there are also a few attractions that date from earlier or later periods.

Taxila is easily the most important Buddhist site in Pakistan; it was a centre of learning from the 5th century BCE to the 5th century CE with many large monasteries and one of the earliest universities in the world. The city attracted monks, nuns, pilgrims and students from across Asia; even today it attracts Buddhist pilgrims from as far as Southeast Asia and Japan. However, it





was never exclusively a Buddhist city; there is a Jain temple among the ruins and the Hindu scholar Pā□ini - who wrote the definitive grammar of Vedic Sanskrit - was certainly a Gandharan and quite likely worked in Taxila.

There is also much to interest modern non-Buddhists; almost anyone with an interest in archaeology, history, art or architecture will find the place fascinating. It was occupied by various empires and was a regional or national capital for many dynasties over the centuries. Persians, Greeks, Central Asians and Hindus have all left their marks on the area.

# Pakistan, EU finalizing strategic engagement plan: Romanian envoy

ISLAMABAD (DNA) - European Union is close to finalizing the 'Strategic Engagement Plan' with Pakistan and the 28 member bloc would also strive for a "constructive and open" engagement between Islamabad and Delhi.

This was stated by Romania's Ambassador Nicolae GOIA, whose country currently holds the rotating presidency of the Council of the European Union, while speaking at a round table discussion on "Romanian Presidency and Prospects for EU-Pakistan Cooperation" at Strategic Vision Institute (SVI).

"We are working on a strategic engagement plan, which is in the last phases of being finalized. It would perhaps be done in next few weeks or possibly a month. Once the plan is put into place, it will take Pak-EU relations to the next level," Ambassador Nicolae said. "We are on the right track for developing this relationship," he further said.

The EU is one of Pakistan's largest trading partners and the biggest market for Pakistani exports. Moreover, EU and Pakistan enjoy good political and security ties, which were governed by an earlier five year engagement plan.

The two sides have been working on adoption of the forthcoming EU-Pakistan Strategic Engagement Plan. The plan is expected to provide a framework for development of broad-based partnership in addition to enhanced economic cooperation in the coming years.

Ambassador Nicolae said the strategic engagement plan would not be 'time bound'. The plan would also bring in obligations for both sides in terms of economic reforms, market access, and human rights, the envoy noted.

He said that there was lot of potential for development of ties between Pakistan and EU as a bloc and individually with member countries and that needs to be fully exploited to take these relationships to the desired level.

He also touched upon the recent tensions between Pakistan and India and said that the steps taken by Pakistan and the progress towards de-escalation was appreciable. He urged both Pakistan and India to resolve the outstanding issues through dialogue.

This is not only the time to calm the situation, but also remove the threats to


peace, he maintained.

EU, as a global network, Ambassador Nicolae said, would not only work for "dialogue between Pakistan and India", but also for making it as "constructive and open" as possible.

Speaking about Pak-EU trade ties, the envoy said, the preferential market access, the GSP+ arrangement, increased Pakistani exports to EU countries by up to 40%.

"These are very significant numbers in terms of volume of Pakistani exports to EU countries and also an incentive for Pakistan to develop ties with EU."


